Comerica Bank Collin 60 Charmed by Trilogy Circuits for Third Time

Collin County Business Press honors EMS provider as one Top 10 fastest growing companies

Richardson, Texas – June 15, 2010 – Trilogy Circuits, a premiere electronic manufacturing services (EMS) provider, was honored by the *Collin County Business Press* at a June 2 luncheon for Comerica Bank Collin 60 awardees. Trilogy Circuits' ranking as the 10th-fastest growing company in Collin County marks the Richardson-based company's third-consecutive Top 10 Collin 60 finish since its inception in 2001. This year, the EMS provider rose to second place in the manufacturing and distribution category.

At the sixth annual Collin 60 ceremony, honorees were recognized for driving innovation, employment and general economic growth in North Texas – an area that boasts 15,000 private companies. In order to qualify for a spot as one of the 60 finalists, a company must have been operating since 2007, be privately owned and have op-line sales of \$250,000 to \$20 million in 2007. The finalists were then ranked by percentage of growth over the last three years.

“We are truly honored to finish in Comerica Collin 60's Top 10 fastest-growing companies for the third year in a row,” said CEO Charles Capers. “Some people say, ‘The third time's a charm,’ but with Collin 60, we've been charmed each year. Every member of our organization has worked tirelessly to help Trilogy Circuits see continued success despite the economy, and being recognized by our hometown business organization for that commitment reminds us why we're so happy to be a part of the Collin County community.”

In addition to realizing more than 382 percent financial growth over the last five years, Trilogy Circuits also recently experienced growth through the expansion of its manufacturing facilities and additions to its industry qualifications. Following the doubling of its production

facilities and headquarters from 10,000 to 20,000 square feet in May, Trilogy Circuits was recognized by the Texas Manufacturing Assistance Center (TMAC) for its achievement of AS9100B Aerospace Quality Standard System Certification for printed circuit board (PCB) layout, fabrication and assembly services. TMAC recently commemorated Trilogy Circuits with an official plaque presented to Capers by U.S. Congressman Pete Sessions, representative of Texas' 32nd district, at a ceremony attended by aerospace and military defense professionals including DRS Technologies, General Dynamics, Raytheon and Rockwell Collins representatives.

“So far, 2010 has been a banner year for Trilogy Circuits,” Capers said. “Our growth is driven by our dedication to consistently deliver the best products, services and support to our customers in the EMS market. In order to maintain the wonderful relationships we’ve built by delivering well-researched, customized PCB solutions and reinforce our growth, we’ll be increasing our work force in the Collin County area by 20 percent this year.

“It’s our great pleasure to give back to our community through creating jobs, and we hope this streak continues,” Capers concluded.
